Most Inspiring Member

To recognize a member that has been an inspiration for our organization.

Innovative Partnerships

To recognize partnerships between companies, government agencies, non-profit groups and political entities that have worked together to accomplish a goal that is supportive of the NAHMMA mission.

SQG Program of the Year

To recognize the most outstanding or most improved SQG Program.

P2 Award

To recognize an individual or organization for outstanding service in promoting pollution prevention.

Believe It or Not!?

To recognize the most unusual or dangerous item received at an HHW or CESQG collection service.

Training Program of the Year

To recognize a training program that encompasses hazardous materials/waste training and education in the SQG and HHW profession.
