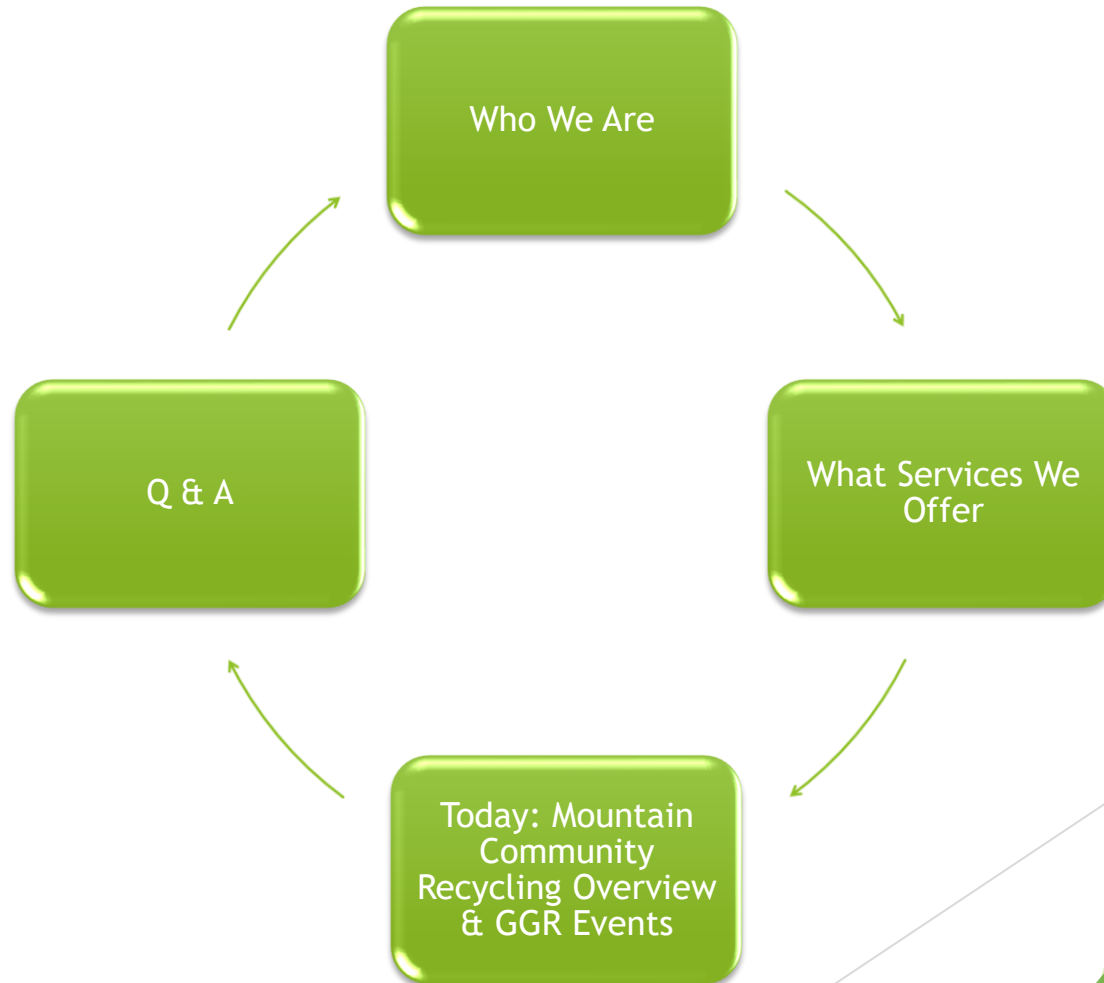

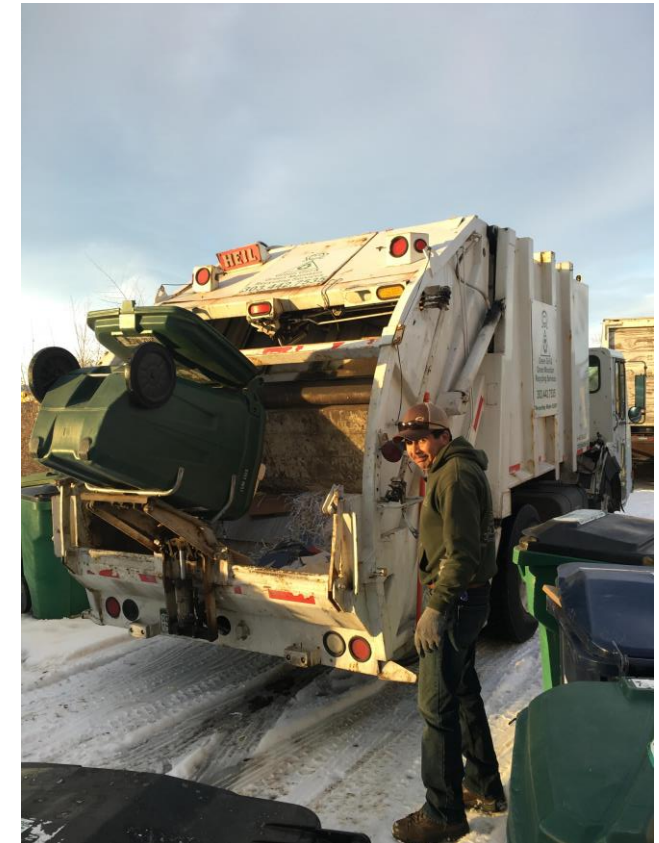

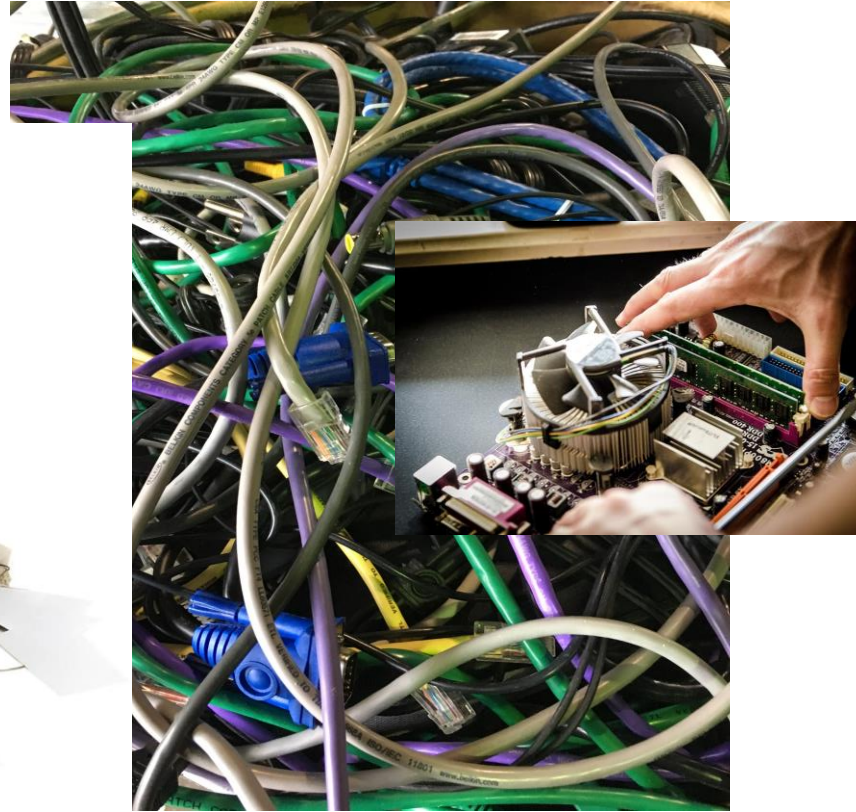

**We recycle CRT and Flat Screen Televisions -
Current pricing:**

- ▶ \$1 per inch to process Flat Screens
- ▶ \$ 3 per inch to process CRT Style Monitors and Televisions
- ▶ \$.95 per pound for large clean-outs (50 + units).

Mid-Grade Electronics



- ▶ Mid grade items are everything NOT High and NOT Low.. Think of items like:
- ▶ (Blenders, Cameras, Espresso Machines, Gaming Consoles - Xbox/Wii/Gameboy/iPads, Microwaves, Mixers, Printers, Radios, Routers, Speakers, Safelight Dishes, Stereos, Telecom equipment, Hand-head devices, Remotes, Video players, recorders, etc. This list is endless)
- ▶ ALL Batteries must be removed!
- ▶ Pricing runs \$.40/lb currently.

High Grade Electronics

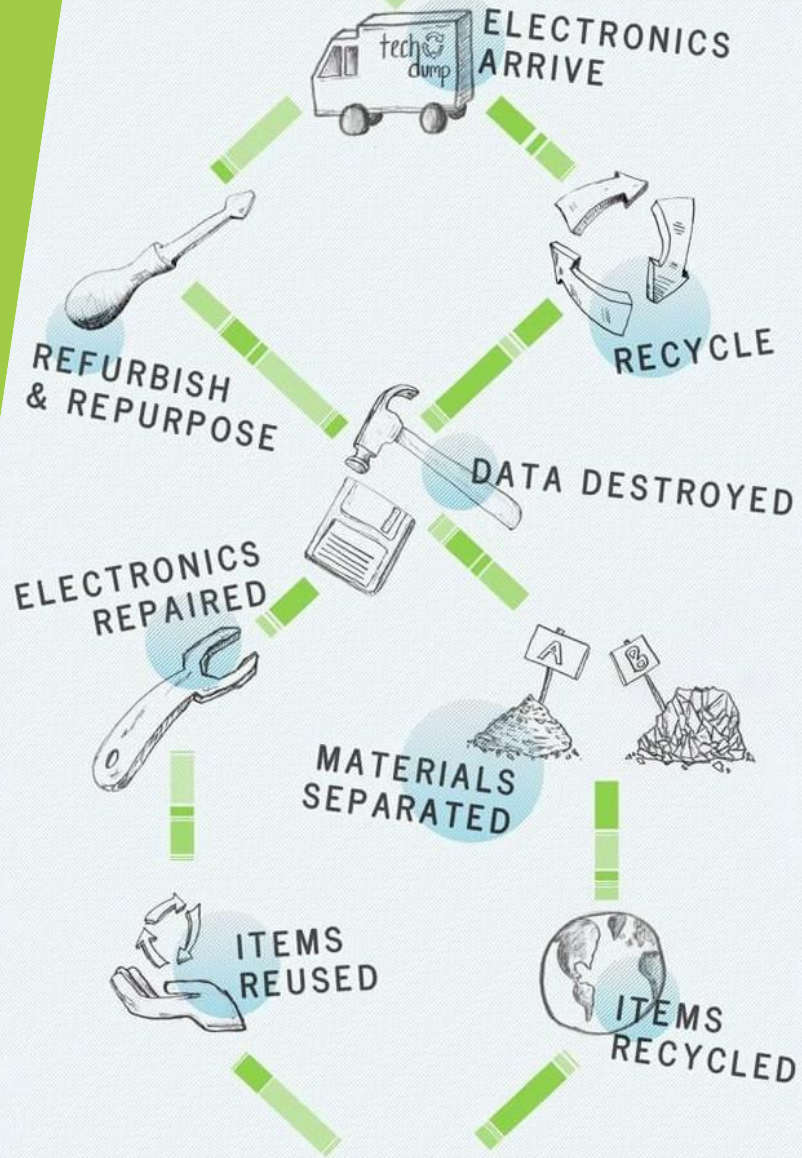


- ▶ High Grade Electronics: Laptops, Towers, Cell Phones, iPads, Circuit Boards
- ▶ These items are *FREE* (delivered to our warehouse)

Extra Services:

- ▶ We can drill Hard Drives in front of customers at our warehouse

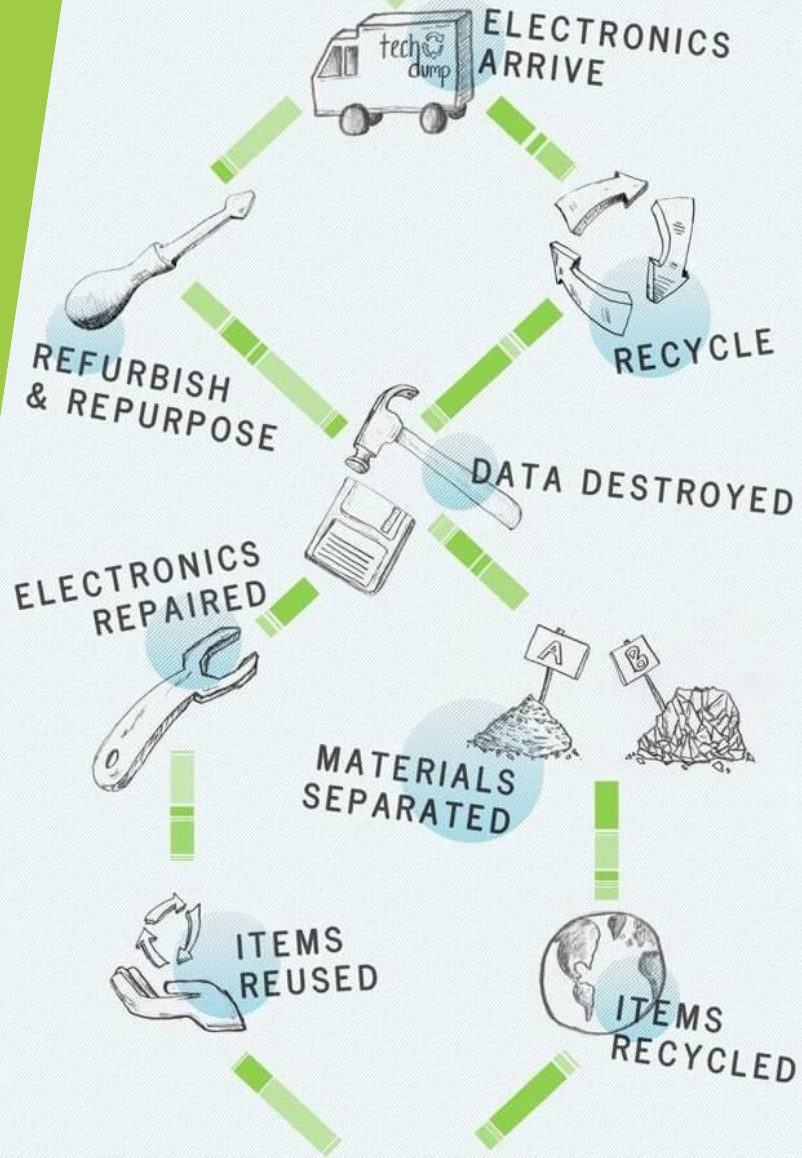

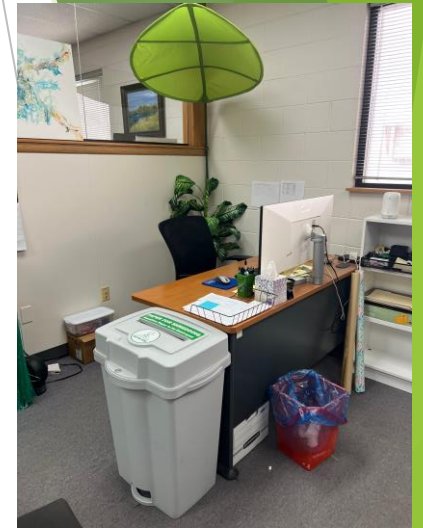

Setting up the Warehouse for HTR -ON SITE-

▶ FLOW: Cones set out to keep people moving, not blocking the front of the warehouse, making the unloading EASY.

▶ ITEMS:

- ▶ Mattresses in the rear on a flatbed truck
- ▶ Porcelain in metal muggies
- ▶ Scrap metal straight into hydraulically tipping truck
- ▶ Electronics into category (low, mid, high in polys),
- ▶ Fire extinguishers in secure bins
- ▶ Rolling Polys and shelves to hold valuable resell able items (old working radios, CRT TVs for Gaming, Monitors that work.
- ▶ We try to give additional life to items where we can!





2023 City Longmont HTR Event

Hard to Recycle items just this event were:

1. Mattresses
2. Fire Extinguishers
3. Porcelain (Toilets and Sinks)
4. Fire Alarms

City of Longmont HTR Events

- ▶ We have helped the City of Longmont the last 3 years in a row offer FULL HTR drop-offs for their FALL Round-Up City give-back event.
- ▶ This year City residents can sign up October 7th through the 19th to drop off HTR items at GGR's Longmont facility.
 - ▶ How it works: Residents go to www.greengirlrecycling.com/event tab and sign up for a day/time and items they want to bring to us.
 - ▶ We send a confirmation email to the resident and track exact numbers, proof of residency and total items diverted daily for the City for the two-week round-up.

Services We Offer at Events:

- Paper Shredding (bagged / boxed)
- Electronics (Low, Mid, High) no batteries
- HTR ITEMS:
 - Clothes/Shoes (in good shape for reuse)
 - # 6 Styrofoam Block
 - Compost (bagged)
 - Toners and Ink Cartridges -
 - Scrap Metals (by the 4x4 truck)
 - Fire Extinguishers / Smoke Detectors
 - Porcelain (toilets & sinks)
 - Bike Tires/Tubes
 - Hard Backed Books
 - Single-Stream / Cardboard

Fees: We charge by the hour and by the truck. Costs can go to customers or flat rate to the town.

Set Up: We work with the community to develop the best collection areas for items.

- Polys left for scheduled time inside a facility (ie. Eco-Products)
- Trucks brought on site (Ward, or Jamestown Round ups)
- Customers coming to us (City Longmont Events)

Hard to Recycle Set Up & 2023 Jamestown Diversion:

Every year the Reuse Area collects very interesting items - It is SO great to see much being reused instead of just tossed away!

Jamestown has created a system where vehicles can flow through the areas to unload Scrap, Hard To Recycle Items, Reuse, Hazardous Waste, and Trash. This system designed by Ken Lenarcic.

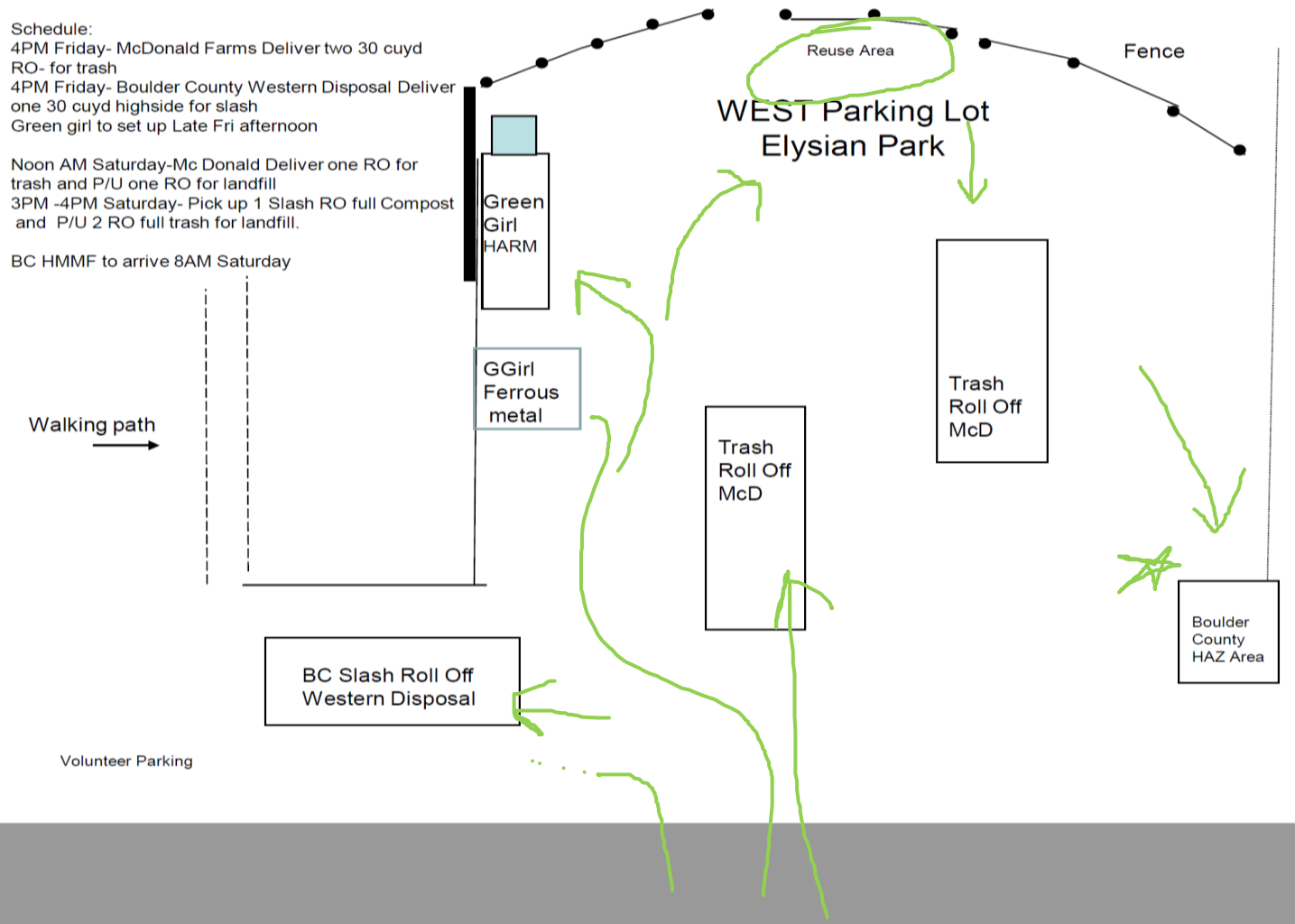
This Works so well because it allows people just dumping trash to use the roll-off's in the middle of the lot and for people sorting and diverting REUSABLE materials: they move around the edges of the park in a clockwise circle.

Diagram for Clean Up Day – June 17/18, 2022

Schedule:
 4PM Friday- McDonald Farms Deliver two 30 cuyd RO- for trash
 4PM Friday- Boulder County Western Disposal Deliver one 30 cuyd highside for slash
 Green girl to set up Late Fri afternoon

Noon AM Saturday-Mc Donald Deliver one RO for trash and P/U one RO for landfill
 3PM -4PM Saturday- Pick up 1 Slash RO full Compost and P/U 2 RO full trash for landfill.

BC HMMF to arrive 8AM Saturday

- ▶ E-waste Mid Grade items: Printers-5, Stereos-4, Wifi Routers-3, Boom Box-2, Record Player-1, Speakers-8, Scanner-1, Microphone-1, Lamp-2, Fax-1, Fan-1, Meter Reader-1, Headsets-2, Gaming Devices-4 (980 lbs.)
- ▶ E-waste High: Laptops-5, Towers-6 (106 lbs.)
- ▶ E-waste Low: 4 TVs (305lbs)
- ▶ Clothing-4 bags
- ▶ Books-210 lbs.
- ▶ Big Plastic Furniture: 2 chairs & table, 10 buckets.
- ▶ Bike Tires - 6

Jamestown 2023 Recycling Report:

Collected over 26 tons of recycling which saved:

- 205 trees (35' tall)
- Prevented 25.82 tons greenhouse gas emissions
- Saved 2,679 BTUs energy
- Diverted 25 tons of raw materials from waste stream
- Saved 12 cubic yards landfill from styrofoam diversion
- Saved 2,679 gallons of oil
- Saved 84,420 gallons of water (enough to fill 168 six-person hot tubs!)

Paper Recycling:

- The paper you recycled was used to make new paper products.
- Using recycled paper to make more paper reduces the need for virgin raw materials.
- Recycled paper requires less water and uses less energy.
- This year you recycled 24,120 pounds of paper
- Through your paper recycling, you helped to save:
 - 205.02 trees (each 35 feet tall)
 - 36.18 tons of wood
 - 84,420 gallons of water (enough to fill 168.84 six-person hot tubs)
- Manufacturing 24,120 pounds of paper WITHOUT using recycled paper would have generated 723.6 pounds of air pollution

Co-mingled Recycling:

- This year you recycled 23,039 pounds of comingled containers (glass, aluminum, etc).
- Through your recycling, you helped to save:
 - 11,519.5 pounds of natural resources
 - 15,320.94 pounds of sand
 - 4,987.94 pounds of soda ash
 - 1,739.44 pounds of feldspar
 - 4,987.94 pounds of limestone
 - 4,423.49 pounds of mining waste NOT NEEDED!

Landfill Space:

- By recycling 51642 pounds of materials, you
 - saved 2,679.45 gallons of oil
 - diverted 25.82 tons of reusable raw materials from the waste stream
 - saved 8.61 cubic yards of landfill space
 - saved 180,747 gallons of water (6,024.9 30 gallon bath tubs)
 - saved .67 cubic yards of landfill space for recycling your plastic bags
 - saved 12 cubic yards of landfill space for recycling your bags of styrofoam

Environmental Impact:

- By recycling 51642 pounds of materials, you
 - saved 2,679.45 million BTUs of energy, or 22,328.71 gallons of gas
 - prevented 25.82 tons of greenhouse gas emissions

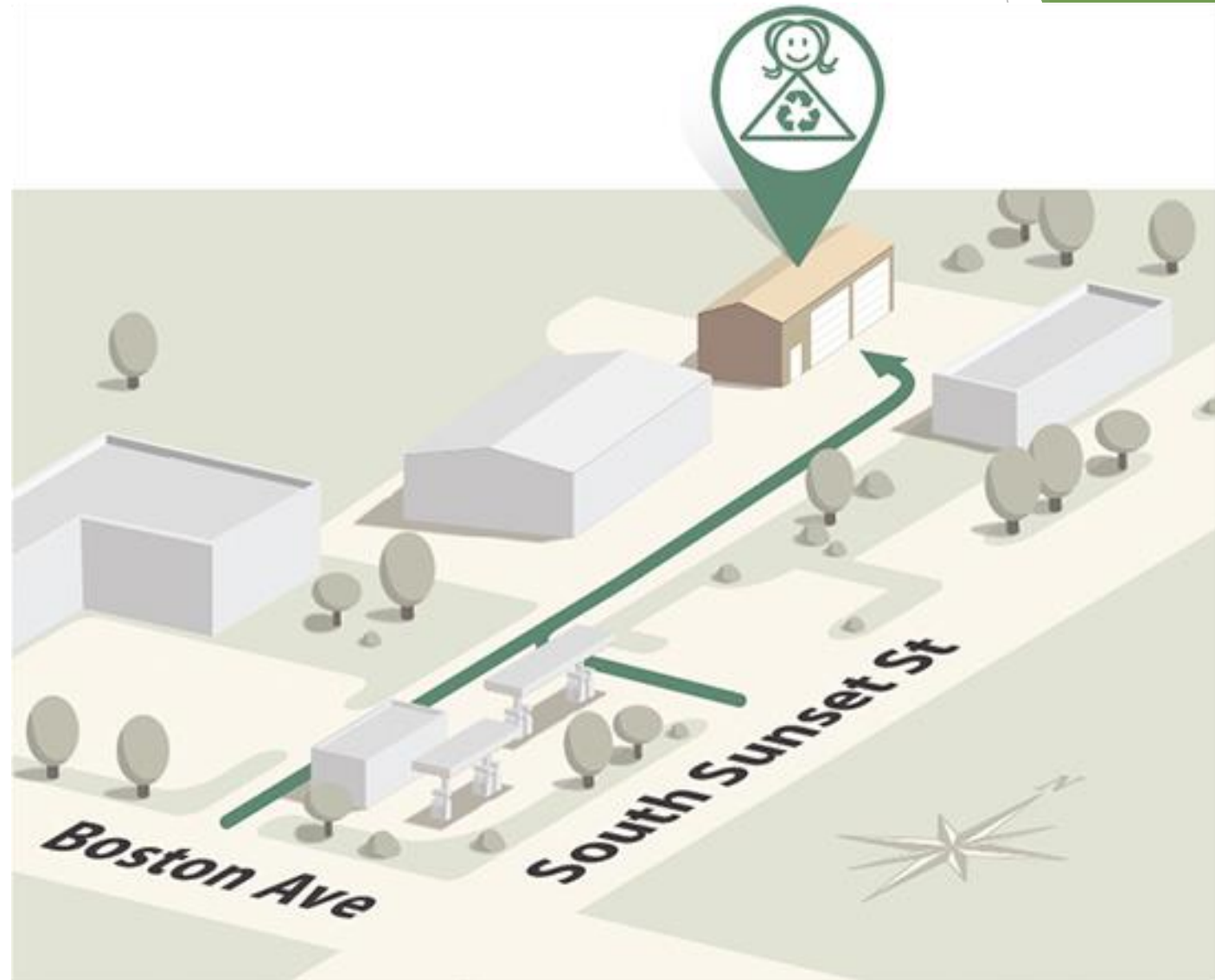
